The Wine

65% Merlot, 28% Cabernet-franc, 7% Malbec

TASTING :

After the first months of ageing, Siaurac 2023 shows great promise. An elegant wine, initial tastings reveal rich, complex aromas, with notes of ripe fruit. On the palate, it has a lovely grain of tannin and good tension, with a smooth, velvety finish.

The Vintage 2023

In 2023, Bordeaux's winegrowing industry is facing a vintage marked by global warming, implying an earlier vine cycle than in recent decades.

The winter of 2023 was characterized by weather averages close to normal, but nevertheless marked by a continuous period of cool weeks with little rainfall from mid-January onwards.

Spring conditions favored the virulence of mildew, posing challenges for vineyards, particularly in Bordeaux.

Beyond this generally difficult situation, 2023 was also a generous vintage in terms of volume, benefiting from excellent ripening conditions, demonstrating once again the ability of vines to adapt to extreme climate conditions.

Harvesting begins on September the 8th on our early parcels, located on the Pomerol plateau, and will last until September the 28th, the time needed to pick each parcel selection at its optimum ripeness.
