Château Siaurac 2023 stands out for its elegance and precision. On the nose, the wine reveals aromas of ripe red and black fruits, enhanced by subtle floral notes and gentle spices. The palate is structured and harmonious, with fine, silky tannins supported by a fine tension that leads to a long, velvety finish. A wine that combines finesse and intensity, showing great promise for the years to come.

Winemaking :

Fermentation in concrete tanks with plot-by-plot selection, followed by 14 months of aging: 60% in concrete tanks, 35% in French Oak barrels, and 5% in amphora.
