Soil : Gravel, deep clays and sandy clays

Winemaking :

Fermentation in concrete tanks with plot-by-plot selection, followed by 14 months of aging: 80% in concrete tanks, 17% in barrels, and 3% in amphoras.

The winter was mild and dry, with a significant water deficit in November, December, and March. The vines grew under hot, dry conditions, with very little rain from May through August; only April saw a water surplus.

Two heatwaves marked June and August, with rainfall returning in late summer. Flowering took place under favorable conditions, but yield potential remained low due to the cold, damp, and low-light conditions of the previous year. The drought and intense summer heat further exacerbated the decline in yield. Nevertheless, the 2025 vintage promises to be of high quality and should fully live up to its promises.
